Description:

The secondary I geography course begins with an introduction to the various terms, concepts and skills that are essential to the study of cities, regions and countries. Following this introduction, students examine a short history and background of selected locations around the world. The course will focus on the following topics: 1) Quebec's Natural Parks, 2) Managing Risk in an Urban Environment, 3) Tourism, 4) Montreal, the Metropolis of Quebec, 5) Quebec's Agricultural Territory.. For each topic, students will learn about the various environmental issues facing decision-makers and the solutions/responses to such issues in particular contexts.

Competencies to be evaluated:

- 1. Understands the organization of a territory
- 2. Interprets a territorial issue
- 3. Constructs his/her consciousness of global citizenship
