Description:

The secondary III history course is a comprehensive introduction to the history of Canada and Quebec. The course is also one which is parented by the Secondary IV history course of the same name and which is required in order to graduate. The students will track the history of Quebec and Canada beginning with the first occupants (Amerindians) and work their way through the development of a *Canadien* society in New France, the British conquest, the struggles of the colony, and the eventual progress towards Unity in 1840

3. Strengthens his/her exercise of citizenship through the study of history
