Description:

The Personal Orientation Project carried out by students in Secondary 3 and 4 in the province of Quebec, gives young people the opportunity to carry out 3-8 individual career explorations in the course of a school year. Students have an active role in deciding which careers interest them and choosing the means to carry out an exploration, whether in the classroom, the school or the community

Students define their personal profile by trying out work functions, doing research and visiting workplaces or educational institutions. They are encouraged to draw on the support of teachers, school staff and classmates, and to interact with parents, workers and other people they trust in the community, discussing their reflections, experiences and discoveries with them.
